PARKING SIGN RESOLUTION

**RESOLVED**, that the City of Hornell Board of Public Safety hereby approves the placement of four "2-Hour Parking" signs on the north side of the Church St. entrance to City Parking Lot # 4.

Mayor Hogan stated that Alderman Harkenrider had received a request from the owner of a business on Church St. asking for these signs.

The Board reviewed a services agreement with CodeRed, an emergency notification system. Mayor Hogan said the agreement is for one year and will then be reviewed. A motion was made by Sengstock and seconded by Huffsmith to approve the agreement.

Chief Smith stated that he has been working with Todd Smith on acquiring a used ambulance in Scranton. Smith commended Todd for the efforts he put in to finding the vehicle and getting a fair price. A motion was made by Sengstock and seconded by Huffsmith to approve the purchase of the 2008 ambulance for \$55,000 pending an inspection by the city head mechanic.

Mayor Hogan has received a letter from Firefighter Dennis Solo notifying him of his intention to retire in two years. The Mayor asked for approval of a motion to appoint Solo "Hydrant Inspector" for the next two years. Motion was made by Sengstock and seconded by Huffsmith.

Chief Murray reported that Patrolman Ryan Harrison will begin training at the academy in January.

Murray requested approval of the following traffic/parking changes:

1. Restrict parking near the driveway at 10 Orchard St. By: Huffsmith/Sengstock
2. Restrict parking near the driveway at 327 Grand St. By: Huffsmith/Sengstock
3. Replace original resolution to place a stop sign on the southwest corner of Rose Ave. at Orchard St. Murray recommended moving the stop sign to Orchard St. to be in compliance with NYS Traffic & Vehicle laws. By: Sengstock/Huffsmith
4. Parking Restriction on west end of Orchard St. By: Huffsmith/Sengstock

These four changes will now go to the Law & Ordinance Committee for approval.
