A request from Danny McManus, representing three tavern owners on River Street, to close the street from noon to 1:30 am on March 16, 2013 for St. Patrick's Day celebrations was discussed. Chief Murray expressed his concern with patrons spilling out onto the street with drinks. Mayor Hogan was concerned about the residents on Jane and John Streets and suggested that maybe they open the street back up at 6:00 pm. Commissioner Sengstock recommended that the tavern owners hire someone to patrol the street to ensure that there were no drinks outside the premises and no underage drinking. Mayor Hogan recommended that instead of closing the street, the City prohibit parking in front of the establishments on that side of River Street. Chiefs Murray and Smith, along with Mitch Cornish will work with Mr. McManus on this.

A request to close the streets around the Hornell Armory (Bennett to Preston) on February 22, 2013 from 8:30 am to 1:30 pm for a Deployment Ceremony was presented. Concern was expressed over closing a major thoroughfare for such a long period. Chief Smith will contact the organizers for more information.
